the ending point is the pink dot.

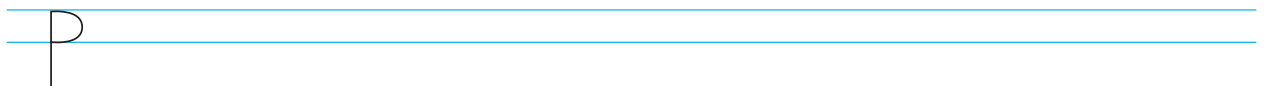
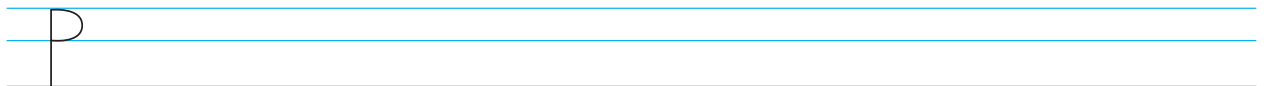
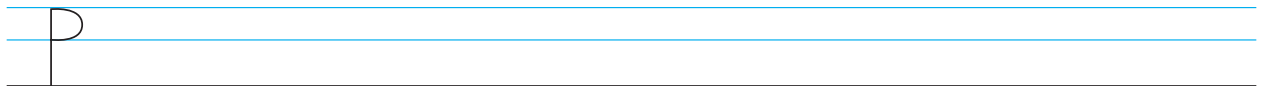
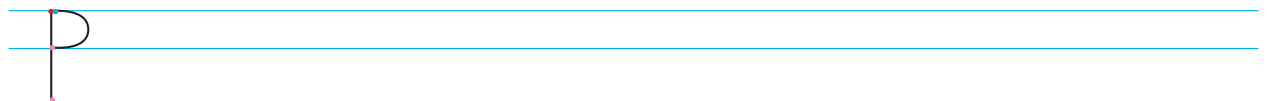
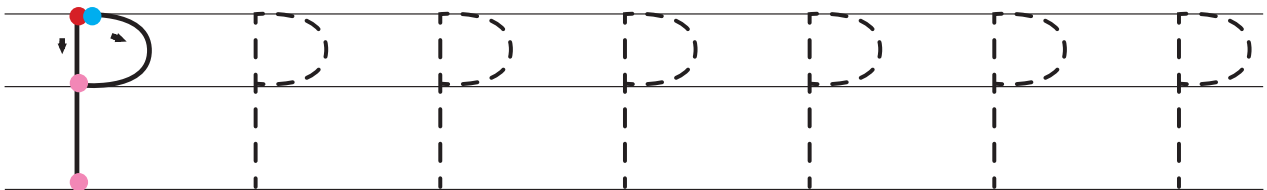

draw a line between the picture and its matching letter.



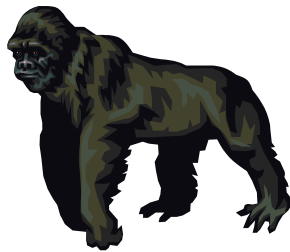
